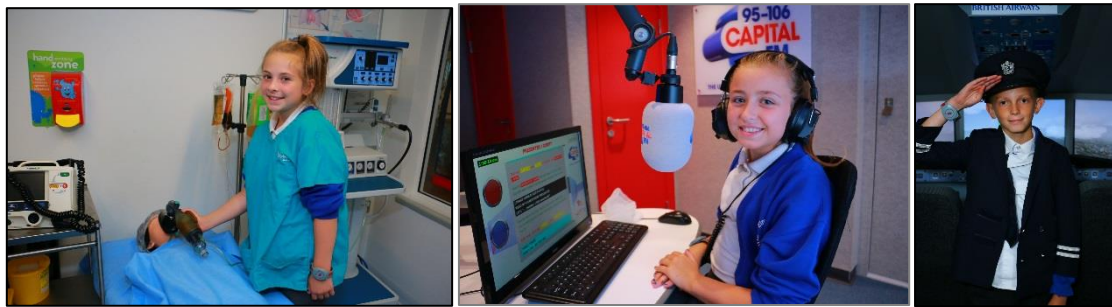


Dinner Money
